Hurley, WI - Iron County Public Health is reporting **489** positive COVID Iron County residents, **112** probable*, (601 total), **536** recovered, **34** ever hospitalized, **2409** negative test results and **37** deaths.

*A person is counted as a probable case of COVID-19 if they are not positive by a confirmatory laboratory test method (for example, a PCR or molecular test), but tested positive using an antigen test method; have symptoms of COVID-19 AND known exposure to COVID-19 (for example, being a close contact of someone who was diagnosed with COVID-19); or list COVID-19 or SARS-CoV-2 on the death certificate.

The Iron County Health Department will again be offering a drive-thru COVID-19 TESTING on **Tuesday, February 9, 2021 from 11:00 AM to 3:00 PM at the Hurley Fire Department**. If you have any symptoms or have been in contact with a positive COVID case, please be tested. Testing is FREE. No appointment is required but you can pre-register on your smart phone at register.covidconnect.wi.gov.

The Iron County Health Department is currently vaccinating the following eligible populations:

- Frontline health care workers
- Nursing home and assisted living residents and staff
- Police, fire department, and correctional staff
- Adults aged 65 and over-Please call the health department at 715-561-2191 to be placed on a waiting list. We will call you for an appointment when vaccine is available.
