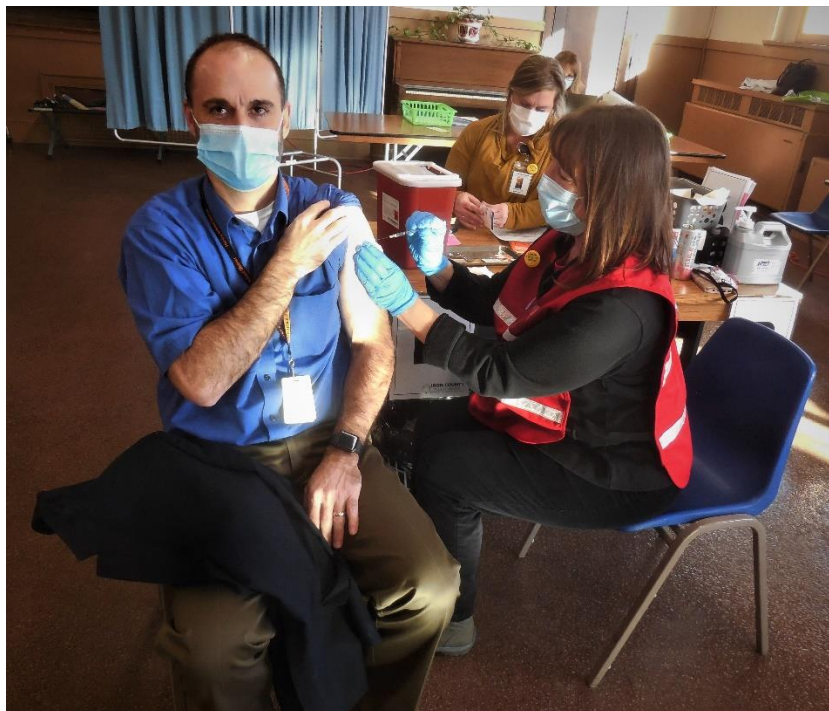

Hurley, WI - Iron County Public Health is reporting **550** positive COVID Iron County residents, **117** probable, (667 total), **608** recovered, **43** ever hospitalized, **2500** negative test results and **40** deaths.

The Iron County Health Department will again be offering a drive-thru COVID-19 TESTING on **Tuesday, March 9, 2021 from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM at the Hurley Fire Department**. If you have any symptoms or have been in contact with a positive COVID case, please be tested. Testing is FREE. No appointment is required but you can pre-register on your smart phone at register.covidconnect.wi.gov.

COVID-19 vaccination clinics were held at the Memorial Building in Hurley on Thursday and Friday this week. 244 vaccinations were administered including second doses and first doses to 65+, Iron County teachers, school staff and some essential workers.
